Introduction to the Mars - Planet Centered Report

Since the Greeks established their pantheon of gods on Mt. Olympus, Ares / Mars has symbolized everything that is energetically out of control. This unruly god allowed his anger to rule his life, creating havoc by instilling fear and terror into human beings and disrupting the orderly flow of life for the gods as well. Phobos and Deimos, Ares' sons, were seen as his attendants, assisting him in upsetting the flow of battle and accompanying him onto the field. They were memorialized on the shield of Atreides, along with Medusa.

Astrologically Mars is indeed energetic, often indicating anger or at least energy used in a reckless manner. Yet there is another side to this planet, one that is revealed in the Mars-centered chart through the placement of Phobos and Deimos. The most direct path to understanding of the full energy of Mars is to consider Aphrodite, the mother of Phobos and Deimos. Mars' two moons, then, reveal the energy of love as well as anger, of calm as well as active energy.

In addition, the relationship between Phobos and Deimos in the Mars-centered chart reveals the easiest approach to the use of energy in your life. Together they reveal choices - options for the use of active energy. Including the earth and other planets, the Mars-centered chart informs you about the place of energy in your life in general, and the role of thought and action in particular.

Introduction to Planets

The planets in any chart are the actors. They mirror life for us. Their placement in and movement through the signs provide a synchronistic reflection of our potential and experience. They also indicate unique expressions of the Solar energy which drives our physical lives. The planets and moons bear the familiar mythological names of gods and goddesses as well as mortals. The myths themselves stand as metaphors for energies and activities which we experience in our day-to-day activities.

Introduction to Signs

The signs provide the background for the movement of planets and moons. From Mars' point of view, they provide twelve filters for the light of the planets and moons and modify or focus their energies.

Introduction to Aspects

An aspect is the angular relationship between two points in a chart. Different aspects indicate different influences between the planets. Thus one person with the Sun in square aspect to Jupiter will have a very different energetic experience from a person with the Sun trine to Jupiter.

Sun Introduction

The Sun represents the direction of your personal mission and spiritual path. The Sun is the source of life, and as such it is one of the most powerful point in the chart. The Sun's placement provides a focus for the conscious experience of your energy. Your Sun sign shows the direction of your energy -- the thrust of your individuality. The house shows where you will exert your energy and where vitality will express most naturally.

The Sun in the Mars-centered chart defines your higher mission from Mars' perspective. Where is the best place to devote your energy? Where the Sun is found. How can you define your life's mission energetically? Where the Sun is found.

Sun in Pisces

The Sun in Pisces in your Mars-centered chart indicates a new start on the path of devotion and compassion. As such it can indicate a lifetime in which you experience the fullest power of Mars' energy. You learn practical outlets for the planetary force. The placement of the Sun in the Mars-centered chart shows the most viable direction, both for understanding energy and for fulfillment of its promise.

The Pisces Sun in your Mars-centered chart indicates an awareness of group experience, coupled with an understanding of the Universe as a whole, as an entity. The highest expression is as mediator in the physical world; the clarity of your intuition is essential to this higher expression, as intellectual focus alone will fail to fulfill the richness of the possibilities.

Sun conjunct Mercury (strong)

You take a practical, common sense approach to cyclical changes in your life. You make new starts in business situations by maintaining a sense of your objectives. If you experience a lack of clarity in the midst of changes, you can balance nervousness with physical activity.

Sun opposition Uranus (weak)

Sudden changes bring new awareness. You have a progressive mind that can manage such changes. You tend to polarize feelings about new relationships.

Sun square Pluto (weak)

Striving for power is the strongest factor in dealing with problems. You will experience remarkable advancement, as well as dramatic health changes, both for the better and for the worse. You have both the positive and less constructive qualities of leadership at your disposal.

Sun square Deimos (strong)

Compassion is part of your heart song, and you know it. Your thoughtfulness provides vital inspiration for all your activities, especially when you need to withdraw.

Sun sextile Neptune (weak)

You are far more sensitive to your environment than most people. Without careful attention to your choices, you make emphasize weaknesses in your physical body. Increased psychic awareness that helps you to make the most of your possibilities.

Sun semi-square Saturn (weak)

The constructive qualities of firmness, modesty and determination develop when you learn to manage tensions caused by difficult struggles and delicate health.

Sun semi-sextile Phobos (strong)

Bold determination marks your actions. Stick close to your buddies when you venture into unknown territory.

Mercury Introduction

Mercury indicates how you communicate with the world at large. Your capabilities as a mediator of conflict are indicated by Mercury's placement and the aspects it makes. This planet also reflects your capacity for writing and all intellectual activities. It shows where you may lose focus or spread your energies too thin. Other people measure your reasoning ability on the basis of how you communicate; thus it is helpful to be aware of the area of life where your energy can be effectively applied to communication tasks.

Mercury in Pisces

Mercury opposition Uranus (weak)

Mercury square Deimos (strong)

You have the courage to come to the aid of others speedily. Thinking first, you are then challenged to say or do what is right, even when you don't wish to do so.

Mercury sextile Neptune (weak)

You have a vivid fantasy life that is connected to some form of psychic activity. While this can produce deceptive currents in your life, it can also develop in you the qualities of compassion and subtle perception. You are seldom surprised by changes, due to your keen foresight.

Mercury semi-square Saturn (weak)

You experienced difficulties in childhood and have had to work hard. Slow steady advancement in life is related to your skills of concentration and industry.

Mercury semi-sextile Earth (weak)

To be in a situation is to think about it, and to think about it is to communicate, either orally or in writing. You especially like to share with a close ally.

Mercury semi-sextile Phobos (strong)

Compulsive communication is part of your natural style. You may talk to yourself when you face big changes, and you definitely share your feelings with close friends.

Venus Introduction

Venus helps you to define your relationship to love and art. It indicates how you engage in relationships of all kinds. Physical attraction is shown by the sign Venus occupies. It also indicates where you gather concrete knowledge easily. Your Mars-centered chart shows how you use physical, mental and emotional energy. Venus indicates where you put your efforts.

Venus in Pisces

Other people sense that you have profound understanding of life and love. How your feet meet the ground is an indication of the level of your intellectual, emotional, and spiritual understanding. If your feet connect with the ground firmly, then your intellect is firmly in charge and your understanding is well developed. When your feet resist the ground, use your mind to re-establish a sense of contact and balance with the world. When you find yourself being overly impressionable, think of the solidity of the ground beneath you and imagine that firmness in your thoughts and desires.

Venus conjunct Phobos (strong)

You express passion in an agitated manner.

Venus conjunct Jupiter (strong)

Venus sextile Pluto (strong)

Venus semi-square Earth (weak)

Venus semi-square Neptune (weak)

Venus quintile Deimos (weak)

Earth Introduction

The Earth represents the direction in which intelligent activity will most likely move. The Earth is obviously where you, the individual are; thus the Earth represents the human capacity to fulfill the potential in your birth chart.

Awareness of yourself and your desires often bears the qualities of the sign where the earth is found, even if you have no planets there.

Earth in Aquarius

Earth trine Deimos (strong)

Earth quincunx Uranus (strong)

Jupiter Introduction

Jupiter indicates the path toward fusion of heart and mind, the subjective purpose of life. This is perhaps the most central experience of wisdom that you will ever have. From any planet-centered perspective, life's processes can be defined by the placement of Jupiter in that chart.

The expansive process of your mind and spirit relishes thought and communication. Meditation on the sign Jupiter occupies in your Mars-centered chart can show you, at the very least, a metaphor for those activities that will lead to the integration of heart and mind through devotion to persons or actions.

Jupiter in Pisces

For you, the urge to grow and expand is directed toward at-one-ment. Your most fruitful activities depend on the mystical balance and peace that permeate all your life processes. You are able to relate to the world at large through your sensitivity to the powers that organize and drive all life. You relate all practical matters to a more mystical Reality.]

Jupiter conjunct Phobos (weak)

Jupiter sextile Pluto (strong)

Jupiter semi-square Neptune (strong)

Jupiter quintile Deimos (weak)

Saturn Introduction

Saturn is the Lord of Karma - the imposer of retribution and the cause of all repayment of debts. This is the first of two indications of Saturn in your chart - that we accumulate debts and responsibilities on the path toward resolution of difficulties. The second indication of Saturn's place in the chart is your individual path to the end of indebtedness when you have freed yourself from the accumulation of Karma. It is through the exercise of intelligent activity - that is, the use of what you know and how you employ that knowledge - that you even begin to approach the freedom you seek. Saturn also reflects the structure of your mind and the way you approach structure in all areas of your life. The key is to remove obstacles and hindrances without surrendering any values that are precious to you. This means that you stop acting expediently and begin to act responsibly.

Saturn in Aries

Saturn semi-square Pluto (weak)

Uranus Introduction

The search for equilibrium in your life reaches beyond the limits of this plane of manifestation, seeking to integrate the experiences of body, mind and spirit into one profound experience of unfolded consciousness. This level of integration occurs when the soul and the personality are brought into alignment through accident or through ritual experience. Thus the practice of ritual offers the principle path for you as you develop a sense of equilibrium.

Uranus tends to bring upset and abrupt change. Incorporation of ritual into your daily life and awareness of the form of ritual can provide a suitable vehicle for traveling life's sometimes bumpy road. Your understanding of ritual can be enhanced by employing it in your daily life. You can use your intuition to determine the form of ritual that can stimulate change effectively.

Uranus in Virgo

Your intuition helps you to make sense of the details of your life in a very different way. You examine every option carefully, and in fact you can generate physical stress and illness through too much mental activity. Such stress can lead to headaches, even migraine. Uranus trine Neptune (strong)

Uranus square Deimos (strong)

Neptune Introduction

Psychic awareness is indicated by the placement of Neptune in your chart. Neptune also focuses your capacity for compassion. Your higher vision is based on your understanding of the essential duality of physical manifestation. One side of the duality is the desire or passionate nature; the other side is the innate quality of compassion that comes from another level of experience. Neptune's sign shows how and where you focus devotional thinking and action.

Neptune in Taurus

You are interested in subcultures that permeate every society. In particular, you tend to seek out cultures that embody industry and patience. You may have had past life experiences, for example, an architect, builder, or manager of grand enterprises.

Neptune semi-sextile Deimos (weak)

You are fascinated by psychic phenomena. You do your best work when other psychics join you to explore phenomena.

Pluto Introduction

The most direct way to actively engage will to guide your personal power is found here. You have the choice

of how you implement your will. At the same time the power of the universe acts through Pluto, and therefore through you. Hence you can use myths about Pluto as a metaphor for the proper context for your will and power. The power and will to act as a human being is demonstrated by the position of Pluto in your chart.

Pluto indicates how you can address the search for resolution of conflict, as well as how to best mobilize your own efforts to maintain or achieve harmonious results from all important endeavors.

Pluto in Taurus

Transformation, for you, carries the promise of applying practical skills to establish your own position in the material world. You are determined to acquire money and property, perhaps because you have experienced times of severe deprivation. To achieve your highest potential, you find that you must focus your intentions and actions persistently and devote your energies to specified goals.

Pluto sextile Phobos (weak)

Phobos Introduction

Phobos, the faster moving satellite of Mars, indicates the active energy of Mars, while Deimos indicates the contemplative side. Integrating passion and compassion, Mars-centered charts define your unique capacity for demonstrating devotion, both actively and in thought. Phobos shows the active energy of creativity; it reveals passion in action. At the extreme Phobos shows the compulsive behavior that agitates the personality.

Phobos in Aries
